Meet Tangible Needs of Newly Arriving Refugee Families

Refugees often flee their homes at a moment's notice. They arrive at our airport with few belongings, a difficult past and high hopes for the future. Welcome Kits provide the basic household items they need for their new start in a place of safety.

BUILD A KIT IN FIVE EASY STEPS

- 1. Pick a Welcome Kit from the list.
- 2. Mobilize your small group, family, church or school to collect the items on the list. *Note: Items may be used, but must be clean and in good condition.*
- 3. Pack items in a sturdy box.

 Note: Large plastic bins/laundry baskets/wastebaskets work well and will be reused by refugee families.
- 4. Contact the Donations Coordinator for delivery or pick-up: EKazadi@wr.org or 509-321-0336
- 5. Along with your kit, a donation of \$25 helps cover transportation and storage costs.
