

## P-2 FSU Lautenberg Family Reunification Petition Eligibility

<b>US Tie</b>	>18 Refugee, Asylee, LPR, US Citizen	
<b>Qualifying Family Members</b>	Spouse Children (biological, step, adopted) Parent Sibling Grandparent Grandchild	
<b>Qualifying Derivatives</b>	On a case-by-case basis, individuals other than the Qualifying Family Member may be eligible if they reside in the same household as the Qualifying Family Member and are part of the same economic unit. This eligibility is determined on a case-by-case basis.	
<b>Eligible Countries</b>	All former Soviet Union countries: Armenia, Azerbaijan, Belarus, Georgia, Kazakhstan, Kyrgyzstan, Latvia, Lithuania, Moldova, Russia, Tajikistan, Turkmenistan, Ukraine, Uzbekistan	
<b>Religious Affiliation</b>	Jewish, Evangelical Christian (Baptist, Pentecostalist, Seventh Day Adventist, Jehovah Witness), Ukrainian Greek Catholic (began participation by 1989 and has been public, active and continuous), Ukrainian Autocephalous (began participation by 1989 and has been public, active and continuous).	
<b>Refugee Status of Qualifying Family Members</b>	Qualifying Family Members' refugee status is presumed.	
<b>Filing Deadline</b>	Annual filing deadline is 9/30. There is no other filing deadline.	
<b>Outcomes</b>	Qualifying Family Members are admitted as refugees.	As refugees, Qualifying Family Members and Qualifying Derivatives receive certain financial support as well as resettlement services.
<b>Process</b>	AOR is sent to the regional RSC for processing. The RSC will contact the Qualifying Family Members for interviews and processing.
