Time Commitment: 3 - 6 month minimum, Sporadic/On-Call

Duties and Responsibilities:

- Assist with moving furniture and household items into apartments
- Ensure that apartment is a clean and welcoming space for individual or family

Skills and Qualifications:

- Able to Lift 10+ lbs
- Willing and able to drive box truck is preferred
- Weekday, day time availability and flexible schedule required—we often only have a day or two of notice for moving a family into their apartment
- Must pass a background and driving check through Sterling Volunteers

Orientation and Training Requirements:

- General World Relief Orientation (2 hours)
- Box truck orientation and training, if you will be driving box truck(1 hour)

Virtual Training Requirements: use wrspokane to make training free
