These classes also build community. Classes range in content from financial literacy, to technology skills, to English language clubs, to health management and more.

Time Commitment: 10-12 week duration, with a 15 hour/week minimum

- Assist Education Center staff with communications to prospective and current students
- Provide transportation to clients
- Assist in the development of child care policies
- Provide fill-in childcare when needed for a class
- Assist students having difficult with technology
- Track student progress in database

- High degree of patience, understanding, organization, and flexibility
- Prior cross-cultural experience
- Ability to speak a second language is preferred
