

ARRIVAL TEAM - Austin

Goal

Welcome Team (Airport Arrival Volunteers) are the first people to welcome a refugee and their family into America by providing transportation to our client's new home.

Duties and Responsibilities

- Receive a request form from World Relief which will include the client's name(s), language, flight number, time, and drop-off location.
 - o Check periodically, at least three hours before, that the flight is on time.
- Use a car to drive to Austin-Bergstrom International Airport, arrive at least 10 minutes in advance to the pick-up time, and park near the correct gate.
 - o Please note that parking in the airport garage is \$5/hour. If you would like parking reimbursement, please keep the receipt to submit to World Relief.
- Identify the client(s) with their IOM bag/identification badges (white with blue lettering) with the same identification information you received previously.
- Assist client(s) with transporting their luggage.
- Assist client(s) with their seatbelts and children with car/booster seats.
- Drive client(s) to their new home.
- After the volunteer opportunity, pick up the client and bring them back to their home and communicate with the case worker and/or Volunteer Coordinator on how it went.

Time Requirements

This is a weekly opportunity that lasts for 3 months, on a needs-basis, and may take 2-3 hours to complete from pick-up to walk-through.

Skills & Qualifications

- Clean driving record.
- Ability to identify and check that all seatbelts and booster seats are properly buckled and secure.
- Patient, adaptable, and timely.
- Responsible with sensitive or confidential information.

Orientation & Training

Complete all onboarding steps in the Volunteer Portal:

- Background Check 5 mins
- Local Live Orientation 1.5 hrs
- E-Learning 45 mins
- References 2 mins

Additional Information

It is encouraged for the volunteers to consistently check for flight delays on the day of arrival. If it is a later airport pick-up, delays are more probable.

If a car seat or booster seat is required for the pick-up, volunteers can borrow one from the World Relief Austin office at 500 E. St. Johns Ave. Austin, TX 78752.

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
