LOCATION: In new family's home, or around the community

TIME COMMITTMENT: 3-month minimum commitment at an agreed upon day of the week/time

RESPONSIBILITIES:

- Build friendship through visits with refugees in their home and around the community
- Assist in an area such as:
 - English conversation practice
 - Providing practical advice (basic finances, sorting mail, etc.)
 - City bus training
 - Visiting a local library
 - Grocery shopping
- Learn about another's culture, values, and experience
- Explore the local community together
- Communicate consistently with the Volunteer Coordinator
- Track your volunteer hours

SKILLS & QUALIFICATIONS:

- Sensitivity and openness to persons of culturally diverse backgrounds
- High degree of patience, understanding, and flexibility
- Complete the volunteer onboarding process, including the orientations and background check
- Record and report volunteer hours, as detailed in the Volunteer Orientation
- Clear time and space in your schedule to meet weekly with a companion
