## From Standing to Building

Earlier this year we stood in the gap for those on the move - responding in solidarity and with generosity when unexpected decisions by our public partners halted anticipated resources. Together, we prayed, welcomed, advocated and gave, ensuring that no one was left behind. And no one was.

## A God on the Move

Today, we are living in the largest displacement crisis in recorded history. Over **120 million people—1 in every 69 worldwide**—have been forced to flee their homes, and heartbreakingly, over 40% are children. Yet in this historic movement of people, we believe **God is moving**.

Acts 17:26 reminds us that God appoints times and places for his people: *“From one man he made all the nations, that they should inhabit the whole earth; and he marked out their appointed times in history and the boundaries of their lands.”*

Yes, this global displacement is a crisis - **but in it**, God is moving in unique and redemptive ways, drawing people to himself through gospel proclamation and gospel demonstration.

*Now, together, we can go further.*

This World Refugee Day is a call for the global Church to step forward as active participants in the redemptive work that God is doing. It's a call to action—rooted in faith, driven by love, and fueled by the unshakable belief that every person, everywhere, matters to God.

As we move forward, building towards the future through **generosity, advocacy and prayer**, we can be a global movement of hope.

### Generosity

## Giving Opportunities

**\$1,000** Can provide 20 Ukrainians with mental healthcare and psychological support for a year.

**\$1,300** Can provide emergency housing for a refugee family in the U.S.

**\$5,000** Can provide nutrition, clean water and hygiene services to 640 Sudanese refugees at the border in Adre, Chad.

**\$15,000** Can provide lifesaving support like emergency food, clean water and shelter for 170 Congolese refugee families who have fled across the border to Burundi and are now living in camps.

**\$25,000** Can repair latrines, provide clean water access and protect the health of 21,000 people living in these Haitian communities.

**\$50,000** Can deliver essential services like nutrition, water, sanitation and hygiene (WASH), and healthcare to thousands of Sudanese refugees who are seeking food and shelter.
