### **ENGLISH CLASS VOLUNTEER** – Austin/Dallas/Fort Worth, Texas

\*In-person and virtual classes available in Fort Worth, Virtual classes only in Dallas and Austin

#### Goal

English Class volunteers help teach and support English Language Learners among World Relief staff and other volunteers in a classroom setting (in person or online) with the goal of all program participants achieving self-sufficiency through language integration.

## **Primary Duties and Responsibilities**

## In-person:

- Lead ELI class includes a 4-week training period for those with little to no experience teaching a class.
- Assist with setup and breakdown
- Contact students regarding attendance via WhatsApp

### Virtual:

- Lead ELI class online via Zoom includes a 4-week training period for those with little to no experience teaching a class.
- Contact students regarding attendance via WhatsApp

- Review (staff-prepared) lesson plans and prep any needed material for class
- Provide students with homework and/or review materials after class via WhatsApp
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- Provide students with homework and/or review materials after class via WhatsApp

# **Secondary Duties and Responsibilities**

- Complete all onboarding steps in the Volunteer Portal:
  - Background Check 5 mins
  - E-Learning 45 mins
  - Complete ESL Tutoring E-Learning Course
- Review confidentiality statement and policies in the National Volunteer Handbook
- Log hours in the Volunteer Portal
- Report any concerns or conflicts to the Volunteer Coordinator

### Time Requirements & Location

Volunteers are asked to commit to teaching at least one day each week for a semester. Volunteers will be able to renew or step away from their commitment at the end of each semester. Volunteers can serve more than one day a week if desired. In-person classes are held in south Fort Worth near crossroads Campus Drive & E Seminary Drive. *The exact address will be given upon onboarding completion*. Virtual classes are held online via Zoom.

### **Skill & Qualification Requirements**

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- Comfortability with cross-cultural engagement
- Passion for teaching and working with refugees and other immigrants
- Proficient reading and writing skills
- Basic technological skills (downloading and using different apps, communicating through email, working on a computer, etc.)
- Suited to work on a team and be a team player

## **Orientation & Training**

- Volunteers are required to complete general onboarding as well as World Relief ESL training, which is assigned by the Volunteer Coordinator.
  - If you are ESL accredited, you are not required to complete World Relief ESL training.
- If there is no previous ESL or teaching experience, the volunteer will be offered a 4-week training period with an ELI teacher.
  - o The volunteer will shadow the ELI class for 4 weeks.
  - The volunteer will lead a class in the 4<sup>th</sup> week while the ELI teacher shadows them. Week 4 will determine if the volunteer is ready to teach on their own.
